The Southampton University Boat Club (SUBC) Alumni Fund has been set up to allow past members to assist the club financially.

The increasingly competitive world of university rowing means that the Boat Club requires higher levels of funding if it is to compete successfully. The University looks favourably on those Athletic Union (AU) clubs who seek to broaden their sources of income and it remains committed to the ongoing support of the Boat Club. To date, we are the only AU society to have arranged such a fund. All money raised will be used on vital equipment and coaching for the teams.

The SUBC Alumni Fund is overseen by a Voluntary Fund Manager with the exact allocation of money decided by the Stags (Boat Club old boys) and SUBC Committees, with the final decisions being made jointly by the Presidents of each Committee and the Fund Manager. The income, withdrawal and final balance of the account will be published annually within a newsletter and distributed to all of our supporters.

The fund has been set up to allow those members who have shown an interest in assisting the club to do so. In addition, we hope that it will strengthen the relationship between the Stags and SUBC and provide a common interest to students during and after their time at Southampton.
